2. What does “Christ” mean?
3. When did God reveal to you that Jesus is the Christ?

BIG IDEA: Jesus is Christ (Messiah-king)

Read Mark 8:11-12

4. Why did the Pharisees want a sign?
5. Was it an issue of “ignorance” or “arrogance”?
6. How does the cultural Christianity of the Bible-south not jive with true Biblical Christianity? In other words, how is Jesus viewed in our culture, versus the Jesus of the Bible? In what ways is Jesus different?
7. So, why is it so important that we see Jesus correctly? What are the implications?

8. What were the disciples most concerned about there in the boat?
9. How are we sometimes like this?

Read Mark 8:18-21

10. What is Jesus most concerned about here?
11. Let Jesus ask you directly, “Do you not yet understand?” What kind of pre-conceived ideas, beliefs, or even pride, keeps us from seeing clearly the Jesus of the Bible?

Read Mark 8:22-24

12. How does this formerly blind man see, but not see?
13. What point is Jesus making for the disciples?

Read Mark 8:25-30, Matthew 16:17

14. Why is it not enough to say Jesus is a good teacher or a worker of miracles?
15. How is the question in verse 29 the central question of the Bible?
16. How might someone actually display pride and arrogance when discussing salvation?
17. Describe the grace that allows us to see salvation clearly.
18. Will someone please share the gospel?
19. What should the true gospel produce in us?

Read Mark 8:31-33

20. What did Peter not understand about Jesus? How does he not quite understand?
21. How can this encourage us?
