Read Mark 3:1-6

1. Religion leads towards cynicism. How can we fight against this?

Read Mark 3:7-10

- 1. How do people go from crowding around Jesus to wanting him dead?
- 2. Many in church don't gather to get Jesus but to get something from Jesus. In what ways are you tempted to have a consumeristic view of church?

Read Mark 3:11-12

- 1. What do we learn about Jesus' identity here?
- 2. Why is there more demonic activity as Jesus' ministry moves forward?
- 3. We can tend to take comfort in our understanding of theology. This doesn't mean we are saved. What is the evidence that we are saved?

Read Mark 3:13-19

- 1. Jesus called to himself those whom he wanted. Jesus saved you out of devotion, not obligation. What implications does that truth have for our daily lives?
- 2. Jesus doesn't save his people to be trophies but to be sent out on mission. You are saved to be sent. How are we sent out on mission?

Read Mark 3:20-27

- 1. Jesus had bad days: rioted by crowds and called crazy by his family. What does this mean for us?
- 2. Jesus probably was the man of the house. His family then betrayed him. How is it comforting that Jesus understands this kind of pain?
- 3. What is Jesus' response when the scribes say he is possessed by Satan?

Read Mark 3:28-30

- 1. What does v 28 mean for all who repent and believe the gospel?
- 2. What is the unforgivable sin/blaspheming against the Holy Spirit?

Read Mark 3:31-35

- 1. Who does Jesus say is his family?
- 2. What is the will of the Father?

Read John 1:11-13
