LEADING OFF...

- 1. Have you ever had a time in your life you felt abandoned?
- 2. Why do we naturally fear abandonment?

BIG IDEA: Jesus is the God who bled and died.

Read Mark 15:1-8

- 3. Why has the truth of our Big Idea become all too common to us, so that we sometimes fail to recognize it's outrageous implications?
- 4. What do we know about Pilate?
- 5. What do we know about Barabbus?
- 6. Why do you think Pilate brings Barabbus out to the crowd?

Read Mark 15:9-15

- 7. How do the religious elite incite the crowd against Jesus?
- 8. How does religion always drive us away from the person of Jesus who saves?
- 9. Why does Pilate ultimately give in to the crowd?
- 10. In verse 15, *"Jesus is sentenced to death."* Pause in silence for a moment. Meditate on these words and let them sink in.
- 11. What are the implications of Jesus allowing this to happen?

Read Mark 15:16-20

- 12. Take a moment and discuss the humiliation Jesus endured by the soldiers who mocked Him and beat Him. We can never comprehend this, but share your thoughts and perspectives on His humiliation.
- 13. What is the significance of the thorns?

Read Mark 15:21-25

- 14. Why might the names of Simon and his sons be mentioned?
- 15. Why was the wine mixed with myrrh offered to Jesus and why did He reject it?
- 16. Verse 24 says *"and they crucified Him."* Take a few minutes and discuss the grace of this act.

Read Mark 15:26-32, John 19:25-27

- 17. What might Mary the mother of Jesus have been experiencing at this moment?
- 18. How does Jesus minister to His mother in His final minutes on the cross?



Read Mark 15:33-34, 37-39

- 19. Jesus was abandoned by His Father. Why had Jesus been dreading this moment above all others? 20. What is the significance of this moment?
- 21. In the worst day of all history, grace comes to us. What are moments of grace we see here?

Read Mark 15:42-47

22. The Son of God is dead. He is laid in a garden tomb. What might be the significance of the garden tomb?
