1. How would you describe true friendship?

## **BIG IDEA: Jesus is our Sustainer and Friend.**

#### Read John 15:1-2

- 2. Read also Isaiah 5:1-7. In light of Isaiah's prophecy, why does Jesus refer to Himself as the "true vine"?
- 3. How does God provide all we need to grow and flourish?
- 4. What is "good fruit" and what is "bad fruit"?
- 5. How do we see the gospel in these two verses in John?
- 6. How are we to correctly interpret these verses in light of our security in Christ?
- 7. What might that "pruning" look like in our lives? Will someone share an example?

#### Read Galatians 5:19-23

8. What do these verses reveal about those who are in Christ and those not in Christ?

#### Read John 15:3-4

- 9. What does Jesus say is His pruning knife?
- 10. How does His Word effectively work in our lives?
- 11. How is God's Word working in your life right now?
- 12. What does it mean to "abide in Christ"?

### Read John 15:5-8

- 13. What are some aspects of a dead branch?
- 14. According to verse 5, what are some evidences of a fruitful branch?
- 15. How does a good prayer life bear evidence of a healthy branch?

### Read John 15:9-11

- 16. What does love have to do with this metaphor of the vine and branches?
- 17. What does obedience have to do with His love?



- 18. How do we sometimes forfeit the inexhaustible joy Jesus offers us?
- 19. Will someone share a testimony of how obedience to Christ brought you much joy?

#### Read John 15:12-15

- 20. How does Jesus set the example for us in obedience, His relationship with the Father, and love for others?
- 21. What might this look like in our biblical community?
- 22. What does it mean to be a friend of God?

- 23. Jesus wraps up this passage here. What is he saying should be the marks of those truly united to the vine?
