Leading Off...

1. Have you ever remembered a time with more questions and uncertainty? Yet, what hope do we as believers have during this difficult time.

BIG IDEA: Jesus is the resurrected Savior.

Read John 20:1-4

- **2.** Who is Mary Magdalene?
- 3. What was the reality of the status of women in this first century culture?

Read John 20:5-15

- **4.** What are some very interesting things you note in these verses? Take some time to discuss these verses.
- **5.** What have we learned about the significance of gardens in the Bible?
- **6.** Why is it significant that Jesus was mistaken as the "gardener" in verse 15?
- 7. Why is it astounding that Jesus would first appear to Mary Magdalene?
- 8. Mary was not to be defined by her past, but by her future, and what Jesus had done for her. How is that true of believers today? Feel free to share any personal testimonies of how God has redefined your future.



Read John 20:19-21

- **9.** Jesus did not come in and tell them all was now fine. He spoke words of peace to calm their troubled spirits. Why is that important for us today?
- **10.** How can we practically put into practice the peace of Christ and trusting Him with our anxieties?

Read John 20:24-29

- **11.** Thomas doubted and needed to know for sure. What can we learn from Thomas?
- **12.** Note that Jesus didn't come down hard on Thomas. What does this tell us about Jesus?

Wrapping Up

Read John 20:30-31

- **13.** The real question is this: "Have you believed?" Discuss these two verses.
- **14.**We don't have a savior abandoned to the grave, but we have a resurrected Savior, who conquered all the things that scare us, even death. Be encouraged with this good news and share testimonies about how God is working in your life during this difficult time.
