Big Idea: Jesus is the Gentle King

- It's easy to minimize our sin by saying, "As long as no one gets hurt, it will be okay." But this passage shows us the collateral damage that is caused by David's sin. List as many people as you can from this passage who were affected by David's sin.
- J.D. Greear said, "Our main problem is not a lustful body but a bored soul." In what ways are you prone to become "bored" with the story and mission of God? What other "stories" that the world offers seem more compelling for you and/or your family to engage in?
- What are things we can do to help draw our attention and affections to God when we grow bored or lazy? What can help prevent growing bored and lazy?
- Even though David committed a terrible sin and many were affected by his actions, Acts 13:22 still describes David as "a man after [God's] heart." What have you learned about God's grace for yourself through how he rebukes, corrects and forgives David?
- What does this passage reveal about Jesus?
