BIG IDEA: Sin destroys relationships.

1. Jesus has used Redeemer in amazing ways in the past 7 years for the gospel! How has Jesus used Redeemer in your life?

Read Genesis 3:1-5

2. This serpent lies to Eve about God. What specific lies are you tempted to believe about God?

Read Genesis 3:6

3. Eve is deceived. Adam rebels. Adam's passivity killed the world. Men, where you do fall to being spiritually passive?

Read Genesis 3:7-8

4. They are trying to cover their shame with tiny fig leaves. We cover our shame and run and hide behind ridiculous things too. How do you cover and hide your shame like Adam and Eve?

Read Genesis 3:9-13

5. Adam blames Eve and then blames God. It breaks the relationship with God and each other. It is the destruction of community. How can our relationships with God and each other be restored?

Read Genesis 3:14-15

6. Here God is promising that a virgin born son will come and defeat the serpent. How does this promise, right after the original sin, bring such comfort and hope to us?

Read Genesis 3:21-24

7. Adam and Eve were kicked out of the garden because of their sin. The rest of the story of the Bible is about God getting his people back to the garden, the garden city, New Jerusalem. To live perfectly with him and each other enjoying God forever. Let's take time to ask Jesus to come back soon and end all that is wrong with the world so we can enjoy him together forever!
