## **Big Idea: Jesus Cleanses Us Freely & Completely**

- C.S. Lewis says it this way, “We can ignore even pleasure. But pain insists upon being attended to. God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks in our conscience, but shouts in our pains: it is his megaphone to rouse a deaf world.” In what ways in your life can you see your pain as opportunities that God was shouting to you and those around you?
- Instead of looking for God, Naaman was just looking for a cure for his leprosy. What are you prone to look for from God over or instead of knowing him?
- Think of the various people God used in Naaman's life and the roles they played in pointing him to God. What people has God used in your life to point you to Him? How might God be using you in other's lives to point them to Him?
- As Naaman demonstrated by obeying God's instructions, God's power is experienced through faith and obedience to his word in the details of life. What small, seemingly insignificant areas of your life have you refused to submit to God that will unlock his power if you obey?
- How does this passage point us to Jesus?
