Read Psalm 50

- What do we learn about God by seeing him here as judge?
- Who does God put "on trial" in verse 5? Why is that? How is that different from what you might have pictured?
 - **1 Peter 4:17** *"For the time has come for judgment to begin with God's household."*
- Why are God's people still held to a standard of righteousness?
 - Luke 12:28 *"From everyone who has been given much, much will be required; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, even more will be expected."*
- Why as followers of Christ are we prompted to repentance?
- Israel was on trial here because they forgot who God is, in what ways are you tempted to do the same? What are the outcomes when we fall to this?
- God has no deficiencies or needs, he is dependent on nothing. What does that tell us about ourselves/what does it change for you?
- In verses 16-21 we see that Israel is hypocritical, that they don't actually live like they are God's people. What should be our motivation for obeying God?
