Leading off...

1. When was a time that you felt unwelcomed or unloved?
2. How does the gospel speak to these feelings that we've all experienced?

BIG IDEA: Jesus loves the unloved

Read John 4:3-9

3. Jesus went out of his way to go after this woman. When and how did Jesus do this for you?
4. Jesus got tired and needed rest. We do too. What gives you life? What gives you rest? How can you better balance work and rest.
5. This Samaritan woman is going to the well at noon alone because of her sinful lifestyle. Her sin has brought her separation and isolation. How can we learn from Jesus' pursuit of this woman in her isolating sin when we see others in the same situation today?

Read John 4:10-15

6. In this exchange between Jesus and this woman we see that true satisfaction in life comes from the creator, not the creation. Where are you tempted to not really believe this?

Read John 4:16-18

7. Part of why this woman has most likely been married and divorced so many times is because she is experiencing infertility. The men have used, abused, and moved on from her. She is in deep pain. How does Jesus love us in the midst of our pain? How can we do this for others too?

Read John 4:19-26

8. She gets uncomfortable with Jesus pointing out her sin and changes the subject. Jesus then points her back to the gospel and says that true worshippers worship in Spirit and truth. How can we worship Jesus in Spirit and truth?

Read John 4:27-29

9. There is a deep religious, cultural, racial, etc divide between the disciples and the Samaritan woman. These are the people that Jesus wants us to take the gospel to. How can we begin to love these people as Jesus does and be on mission for them like Jesus?

Read John 4:39-42

10. This woman shared her testimony and pointed them to Jesus. Because of her testimony and them then meeting Jesus too, many believed the gospel with her. How can we learn from this example and apply it to our lives?

Wrapping Up...**Read Romans 5:6-8**

11. Is your life marked by abandonment, rejection, hurt, or wounds? Friends, remember the good news of this week's big idea: Jesus loves the unloved.
