- Why does Jesus ask "Who touched me?" according to the Gospel of Mark? Why is it important for our faith to be a public, confessed faith?
- How does it make you feel to know that disease fears Jesus?
- How can we find comfort in the resurrection of Jesus?
- Read Mark 5:36, what do you need to believe about God in order to not be afraid?
