BIG IDEA: The son who saves secures our adoption and guarantees our inheritance.

Read Genesis 47:1-6

- Pharaoh looks at Joseph and tells him that his family will get the best land located in Goshen.
- Joseph is foreshadowing Jesus in this passage. He is standing in the throne room as an advocate for those who trust him.
- Joseph's appeal was not based on his family's performance but rather what he had done.
- **How has your view and understanding of Joseph changed over the past few weeks? Do you see him more clearly as a Christ figure? Why or why not?**

Read Genesis 48:1-6

- Jacob nears the end of his life and he shares with Joseph his story of meeting God and the promises that were made.
- Jacob makes an unexpected decision and adopts Joseph's sons to receive part of the inheritance that they otherwise would not have received.
- Jacob is picturing what God has done for us. He is adopting those who do not deserve it because of what His Son has done.
- **What will you be remembered for? What would be your final legacy?**

Read Genesis 49:1,33

- Jacob finishes his life by blessing his sons.
- The unrepentant get nothing and the repentant get everything.
- Jesus does this for us. He guarantees the blessing of eternal life for disobedient sons and daughters who repent and believe the gospel.
- **What sin do you need to repent of? What has been holding you back?**

Read Galatians 4:4-7

- Because of Jesus, we go from being strangers to adopted sons and daughters.
- **What are ways you can live as an adopted son or daughter instead of a foreigner?**
