



JOHN 3:1-15

1. In John 3:1-2, Nicodemus acknowledges Jesus' miracles as signs of His divine authority. Considering this, how does the miracle of salvation through Jesus Christ manifest in our lives today, and how can we better recognize and appreciate this gift from God?
2. John 3:3 emphasizes the necessity of being "born again" to see the Kingdom of God. How does this spiritual rebirth, made possible only through Jesus Christ, transform your perspectives and encourage you to engage the world through the gospel?
3. In John 3:8, Jesus uses the metaphor of the wind to describe the work of the Spirit. How does the transformative power of the Holy Spirit, given to us through Christ's sacrifice, bring about changes in our lives ?
4. Nicodemus struggles with the concept of spiritual rebirth in John 3:9-10. Can you share a time when God brought revelation to you heart through His Word, and how that has that changed your love for scripture and evangelism?
5. Jesus foretells His crucifixion and the salvation it will bring in John 3:13-15. How does recognizing Jesus as our Savior, who came down from heaven to give us eternal life, influence you to live out the gospel?
