Plenary Indulgence at Our Lady Rosa Mystica Shrine

Jubilee Year of Hope 2025 - Diocese of Albany, New York

In this extraordinary Jubilee Year of Hope 2025, His Excellency, The Most Reverend Edward B. Scharfenberger, Bishop of Albany, has designated *Our Lady Rosa Mystica Shrine* in Edmeston, New York as a sacred site where the faithful may obtain a *Plenary Indulgence* — a great grace of spiritual renewal and healing granted by the mercy of God through the Church.

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

A Plenary Indulgence is the full remission of all temporal punishment due to sin. It does not forgive sin itself — that happens in Confession — but it removes the temporal effects of forgiven sin, helping the soul to be purified and more prepared for heaven.

Who Can Obtain It?

Any baptized Catholic who is in the state of grace, who fulfills the required conditions, and who has the interior disposition of complete detachment from all sin — even venial sin.

Steps to Obtain Plenary Indulgence at Rosa Mystica Shrine

1. Make a Sacred Pilgrimage

Visit Our Lady Rosa Mystica Shrine in Edmeston, NY during the Jubilee Year of Hope 2025.

2. Perform a Work of Mercy or Sacrifice

Choose one or more of these actions: Pray for someone in need, Forgive an offense, Offer a personal sacrifice or penance, Perform an act of kindness or charity, Give alms to the poor, Comfort the sorrowful, Offer your pilgrimage for others.

3. Pray at the Shrine

Pray: Our Father, Profession of Faith, Prayer for the intentions of the Pope. Optional: Holy Rosary or Rosa Mystica Prayers.

4. Go to Confession

Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within about 20 days before or after your visit.

5. Receive Holy Communion

Attend Mass and receive the Eucharist — preferably on your pilgrimage day or soon after.

The Heart of the Pilgrim

A Plenary Indulgence requires freedom from all attachment to sin, even venial sin. A Partial Indulgence is still granted if not fully detached.
