 - A. The law of God tells me.1
- 4 Q. What does God's law require of us?
- A. Christ teaches us this in summary in Matthew 22—;

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.^{2*} This is the first and greatest commandment.

And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.³

All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

*Earlier and better manuscripts of Matthew 22 omit the words "and with all your strength." They are found in Mark 12:30.
