### The Heidelberg Catechism in the 21st Century

#### LORD'S DAY EIGHT

**24 Q. How are these articles divided?**

- A. Into three parts:  
God the Father and our creation;  
God the Son and our deliverance;  
God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

**25 Q. Since there is but one God,<sup>1</sup> why do you speak of three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?**

- A. Because that is how  
God has revealed himself in his Word:<sup>2</sup>  
these three distinct persons  
are one, true, eternal God.
