CHURCH SCHOOL LESSON: "Abram Builds an Altar" Scripture Reading: Genesis 13:8-18

Key Verse: "So Abram went to live near the great trees of Mamre at Hebron, where he pitched his tents.

There he built an altar to the Lord." Genesis 13:18

SUMMARY OF THE LESSON: Genesis: the book of beginnings. In it we find the creation of the universe and planet earth, origin of human beings, marriage, families, nations, industry, artistic expression, religious ritual, prophecy, sin, law, crime, conflict, punishment and death. Genesis is a view of the realities that shape our daily existence. That perfect place where God placed mankind had everything needed to sustain life, including the sweet communion with God Himself. Because they yielded to distraction of the words of the serpent, they had to be expelled. Evil grew rampant and it threatened to destroy everything that was good. God saw the wickedness was great in the earth and that every imagination of the thoughts of man's heart was only evil continually. God's plan and purpose aimed at restoration because of His mercy and Grace. He chose Noah to give the world a new beginning. You know the story. Instead of spreading out and doing as God commanded, they built a tower. Perhaps they thought they could establish a worldwide empire that would be independent of God. In judgment, God sent a confusion of tongues and scattered them abroad. God's plan and purpose has always been, and is now, restoration of the right relationship with Him. Despite the wickedness of the human heart, God wanted to show His Grace. He wanted a chosen people: to whom He might trust the Holy Scriptures; to be a witness to other nations; and through whom the promised Messiah could come. God called Abram, saying go where I will show you; "I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." (Genesis 12:1-4). Sometimes God must separate us from relationships, events, and jobs that stand between us and Him. Obedience to God often means leaving one thing to receive something better. God may not reveal all the details of the how and why. If He did, there would be no room for faith. The Bible says Abram went to Canaan with all that he had, including wife and nephew Lot. Abram was very rich in livestock, herds and herdsmen, tents, and after a needed trip to Egypt, silver and gold. Lot also had livestock and herds and herdsmen and tents, but the land couldn't support them while they stayed together for their possessions were so great. "And quarreling arose between Abram's herders and Lot's." ((Genesis 13:5-7). It's amazing how family dynamics can change when there is a benefit at stake, i.e. money, property, land. How to respond to family conflict is an important issue in this lesson. The decision Lot made was based on the compromise by Abram. Conflict resolution is an important tool in any group. The Bible says, "put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another, even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection." (Colossians 3:12-14). Abram lived in Canaan while Lot pitched his tent near Sodom. You know the story of Lot and Sodom. The decision Lot made turned out to be one that led to a disaster for him and his family, as he found himself among evil and destructive forces. My mother used to say, "be careful about the company you keep", meaning such association can be an obstacle between you and God. I believe Lot chose selfishly the best part, thinking only about the land and the availability of water. He did not think about the moral environment of the people he would associate with and be influenced by. On the other hand, because Abram was obedient to the call of God; who trusted God enough to leave his comfort zone; and who believed the promises God made, his response was that of gratitude and worship. Faith is a requirement for the believer. Is yours strong enough? Remember what He has done, because He's still doing it. Believe it! Amen.


