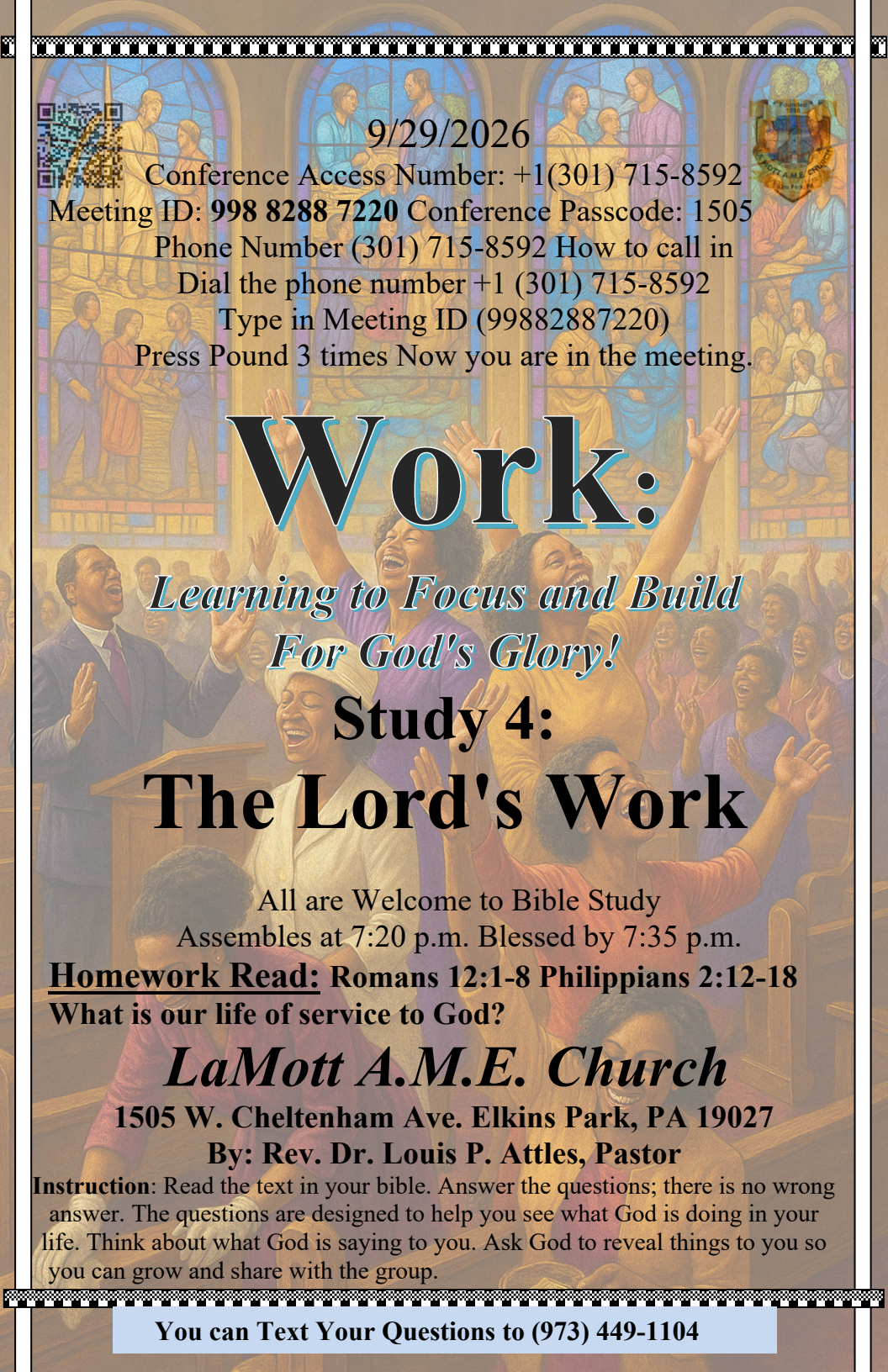

What is our life of service to God?

The Lord's Work challenges the very lens through which we view our daily labor. In Colossians 3:1–25, we are invited to shift our focus—not merely to tasks and timelines, but to the vision of eternity. “Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven.” Working for God means our effort no longer centers on earthly applause, but on the unseen call of Christ.

Here, Paul makes clear that our work whether in home, office, or church—is spiritual by nature. We put to death the old self, clothe ourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, and above all, love. That means the natural things we do—meetings, emails, children, chores become vessels for the supernatural purpose of God’s kingdom. The visible act of service reflects the invisible reality of Christ’s presence.

God reveals Himself here as the One who redeems all our work—not just the big moments, but the quiet, repetitive ones. He calls us to build not for human recognition, but for His glory. When we align our work with His vision, even the mundane becomes magnificent.

As you begin this study, reflect:

- How does your current work connect to the “realities of heaven” rather than simply the “tasks of earth”?
- Where might you put off the old self and put on the new nature in your daily routines?
- What part of your work can you now offer *as unto the Lord*, not just as unto men?

The Lord's Work invites us to build with purpose, serve with humility, and labor with eternity in view.

1. What should believers set their sights on? _____

“Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God’s right hand.” Colossians 3:1 NLT

2. What should we think about? _____.

“Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth.” Colossians 3:2 NLT

3. What happened to our old life? _____.

“For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God. And when Christ, who is your life, is revealed to the whole world, you will share in all his glory.” Colossians 3:3-4 NLT

4. What should we put to death? _____

“So put to death the sinful, earthly things lurking within you. Have nothing to do with sexual immorality, impurity, lust, and evil desires. Don’t be greedy, for a greedy person is an idolater, worshipping the things of this world. ⁶Because of these sins, the anger of God is coming. ⁷You used to do these things when your life was still part of this world.” Colossians 3:5-7 NLT

5. What attitudes must we remove? _____

“But now is the time to get rid of anger, rage, malicious behavior, slander, and dirty language. Don’t lie to each other, for you have stripped off your old sinful nature and all its wicked deeds.” Colossians 3:8-9 NLT

6. What new identity do we wear? _____

“Put on your new nature, and be renewed as you learn to know your Creator and become like him. In this new life, it doesn’t matter if you are a Jew or a Gentile, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbaric, uncivilized, slave, or free. Christ is all that matters, and he lives in all of us.” Colossians 3:10-11 NLT

7. What virtues should we clothe ourselves with? _____

“Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.” Colossians 3:12 NLT

8. What should we do when wronged? _____

“Make allowance for each other’s faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.” Colossians 3:13

9. What binds all virtues together? _____

“Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony.” Colossians 3:14 NLT

10. What should rule our hearts? _____

“And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful.” Colossians 3:15

11. What should fill our lives? _____

“Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts.” Colossians 3:16
