CHURCH SCHOOL LESSON: "The Love of God" Scripture Reading: 1 John 3"1-10 Key Verse: "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! ## **SUMMARY OF THE LESSON:**

The Letters of John: 1, 2, and 3 are attributed to John "the disciple whom Jesus loved"; one of the twelve disciples and along with Peter and John's brother, James, was considered one of Jesus' closest followers. The emphasis of the lesson text is the great love that God has for humanity. It is a love that nothing that humanity could do to deserve God's love. Nevertheless, God showed His love by sending His only Son, Jesus Christ to earth for our sins. Jesus Christ came to do what we could never do for ourselves; to provide forgiveness of our sins and the promise of everlasting life. When people demonstrate faith in Jesus, they become 'children of God', the adoption of which happens through the transforming power of the Holy Spirit. Calling ourselves believers means that we accept the Message of God; faith in Jesus Christ; obedient response to God's commands; and love for God and others from the heart. The early church had its problems from within and from the outside. The infiltration of different ideas about 'special knowledge' as a means of attaining salvation contrary to the Message from God. Apparently, there were varying ideas about who Jesus was: body and/or spirit. John's response to the false teachings, "Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous. He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil." (1 John 3:7,8). John can say who Jesus was because he was a witness to His life and death. John walked with Jesus; heard Him speak and saw what He could do. John's Letters are intended to remind the believers not to fall prey to any word, or ideas contrary to the Message that they have accepted by faith; to protect them from false teachers; that even if they do sin, forgiveness is available. John's Letters: 1, 2, 3 were written so that the believer might know they had eternal life; that they believe in the name of the Son of God; that they might avoid destructive beliefs and behaviors to which some had fallen prey; that they might love one another. Be reminded, of all the instructions given in the Law of Moses, two stand our very clearly: love God; love your neighbor. It remains extremely important for believers under the New Covenant. We have witnessed certain groups of believers who embraced, and prayed for, the 2020 presidential candidate's agenda of discrimination, oppression, the exclusion of certain groups from equal opportunity, the dismantling of the health care system and education. We are living in chaotic times. We see the dangers of sin play out in real time and they are not hidden. We are witnesses to a time when society, even those who profess faith, appear to ignore the need for God; some may even deny His existence. We can, however, rest assured and remember the examples of the faith of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; the messages of hope from the prophets like Isaiah and Jeremiah: that what God has done in the past. He will do in the present and future. God is still in control even when we feel disappointed, frustrated, or confused. The writer or Proverbs wisely says, "Many are the plans in man's heart, but it is the Lord's purpose that prevails." (Proverbs 19:21). "See what great love the Father has lavished on us that we should be called children of God!" (1 John 3:1a). Act like it! Challenge accepted: love God; love your neighbor. "What's love got to do with it?" It is not enough to know this. It is extremely important that you do this. PRACTICE WHAT YOU PREACH! Amen.
