Hebrews 6:19-20 Happy Birthday – Bro. Stan Williams

Summary of the lesson:

Life is difficult at times and often it seems unfair. Even when we try to do our best for God, family, and others we are not immune from having to walk through the difficult and uncertain avenues of life. Sometimes it appears that the ungodly who have no concern about righteous living are faring better than the faithful follower of God Those times put our heart's attitude to the test. Even then, with the guidance of God's Word and the empowerment of His Spirit, we can maintain a tender heart that allows our lives to shine in a dark world. We live in a world wherein people are struggling with homelessness, abusive households and workplaces, discriminating practices, theft, greed, hate and deception persists. Times have changed, people haven't. The letter to the Hebrews was written to a people suffering persecution because of their beliefs. They were reminded not to allow their hearts to become hardened through unbelief and rebellion; to remember how God led them to the Promised Land; to remember that doubt and rebellion caused their hearts to be hardened spiritually and their condition came at a high price. The Letter is also a source of encouragement to not give up, give in or give out; to stand on the promises of God. The Letter serves as a reminder for the believer of the promise made to Abraham; that the promise has been fulfilled through the blood of Christ that offers grace, mercy, forgiveness and salvation. "God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you have shown Him, as you have helped His people and continue to help them." (v. 10). In other words, keep doing what you know to be good and right, despite the circumstances. There is the hope of peace and rest when you do so. Yes, we get tired, but we are called not to become lazy but to look to and imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised; to faithfully follow those who have been faithful in ministry; to not only be hearers of the Word but also to be doers. How is it that one can begin believing with deep devotion, finding ways to serve God, yet over time find that commitment to God wavered? Is it because our expectations have not been met? Is God taking too long to fix your circumstance? Life is a struggle and faith, and patience are required. God made a promise to Abraham. We are the inheritors of that promise through the life, work, death and resurrection of Christ. Yes, it took hundreds of years between the promise made and the promise kept, nevertheless, it was done! The Letter is a reminder that God is righteous. He is faithful. He is just He does not change. He keeps His promise. He can do anything but fail. So many witnesses attest to these facts. Search His Word from Genesis to Revelation and you will learn of humanity's weaknesses and suffering and God's righteous, merciful, protective, and just response to it and the fulfillment of the promise in the work of Christ on the cross. The debt of the consequences of sin has been paid. This is a life-changing truth upon which we can rely. We are to encourage one another of this life-changing truth that guides us to honor God and do good to others no matter what phase of life we are in. Stand strong! Amen.
