BLACK HISTORY MOMENT:

<u>Lula Mae Hardaway</u> (January 11, 1930 – May 31, 2006) was an American songwriter and the mother of musical genius Stevie Wonder. She spent her early adult life in Saginaw, Michigan., but from 1975 until her death in 2006, lived in Los Angeles, California She was the daughter of sharecropper. she married Calvin Judkin, She had three children. The blindness of her third child, Stevland, is attributed to having been born weeks prematurely and then receiving too much oxygen in an incubator. She moved to Detroit with her three children. The musical talents of Stevland – who by the age of 10 "was playing and singing gospel tunes in church, and then joining adults singing rhythm and blues on the street corners" – came to the notice of Berry Gordy, founder of Motown Records, who dubbed him "Little Stevie Wonder".

Did you know that she co-wrote many of her son's songs during his teenage years, including the hit singles "I Was Made to Love Her", "Signed, Sealed, Delivered I'm Yours", "You Met Your Match" and "I Don't Know Why I Love You", co-writing four songs on the 1968 album *For Once in My Life*. For co-writing "Signed, Sealed, Delivered", she was co-nominated for the 1970 Grammy Award for Best R&B Song. In 1974, Hardaway was with her then 23-year-old son at the Hollywood Palladium when he received his first Grammy, one of several he received that night.

<u>James Earl Jones</u> (January 17, 1931 – September 9, 2024) was an American actor known for his iconic voice, and his many tag lines, film roles and his work in theater. He was one of the few performers to achieve the EGOT (Emmy, Grammy, Oscar, and Tony).

<u>Frankie Beverly</u> (born Howard Beverly; (December 6, 1946 – Sept, 10, 2024) a Philadelphia Native, was an American singer, songwriter, and producer. He began singing gospel music as a schoolboy in a local church. He was known for his distinctive smooth baritone voice and charismatic stage presence.
