

REVIEW

In order to address the problem of false teachers of the law, Paul leaves Timothy in Ephesus.

Timothy is to do the following:

- 1) confront those who are incorrectly teaching the law of Moses (chapter 1),
- 2) encourage men and women to conduct themselves properly,
- 3) appoint overseers and deacons to assist in the leading of the church, and 4) conduct himself in a manner that is fitting (chapters 4-6).



MONDAY

Listen to the 1 Timothy 5 podcast.

TUESDAY

Read Leviticus 19:32 and Proverbs 23:22 in light of 1 Timothy 5:1-2.

Is Paul instructing Timothy in any new teaching?

WEDNESDAY

Read Exodus 22:21; Deuteronomy 10:12-18; 14:29; 16:11,14; 24:17-21; and 27:19 in light of 1 Timothy 5:3-16.

Is Paul instructing Timothy in any new teaching?



THURSDAY

Read 1 Timothy 3 in light of 1 Timothy 5:9-10.

Are all believers supposed to exhibit these same qualities?

Is this a new teaching by Paul?



FRIDAY

Read Deuteronomy 17:6; 19:15; and Numbers 35:30 in light of 1 Timothy 5:19.

Is Paul instructing Timothy in any new teaching?
