See in Psalm 22, which is the passage we're studying today, just as in Psalm 16, which we read yesterday, David reflects again on the coming of his future son, the coming of the Messiah who would sit on his throne forever. In this Psalm, David prophesies what kind of death the Messiah, what kind of death his son would experience. The Messiah's death would be so that it appears that the Lord had forsaken him. His hands and feet would be pierced. His garments would be divided up by his attackers, by those who hated him. However, the Psalm doesn't end there. The Lord will hear his cries and will not forsake him. Just as we read yesterday in Psalm 16, the Lord will not abandon his soul to the grave, and so today we learn that he will be crucified.
