- ⇒ Reflect on King David’s words in 2 Samuel 18:33. Both David and his son Absalom had substantial God-given giftedness. Absalom chose an even more worldly lifelong expression of his gifts and lacked the true heart for God that King David had.
 - ⇒ What do you think their key differences were? After all, more than 20K of Israel’s soldiers lost their lives in support of Absalom taking the Kingship away from his father, David.

- ⇒ Do you think God forgave Judas for betraying Jesus? Why or why not?

- ⇒ What are the implications for us if we choose to judge someone versus letting God do the final judging?
