SCRIPTURE READING

Jeremiah 31:31-34; Ezekiel 36:25-27; Deuteronomy 30:1-6; Hebrews 8:8-12;
2 Corinthians 3:7-11; Romans 7:1-13; 11:25-27; John 7:37-38

STUDY QUESTIONS

1. What does the promise of a “new covenant” reveal about God’s character (31:31)? How is this different from a rule-based relationship with God? Why do you think God chose to start something new instead of fixing the old?
2. What does it practically look like for God to write His law on your heart (33:33)? Where do you still rely more on external rules than inward change? What’s one area where God may be reshaping your desires right now?
3. What’s the difference between knowing about God and truly knowing Him (31:34)? Where do you see a gap between what you know and how you live? What is one habit that could help you grow in a real relationship with God?
4. Which promise in 31:33-34 stands out most to you: A new heart? A restored relationship? Full forgiveness? Why? Do you truly live as someone forgiven? Are you holding onto guilt that God has already released? Is there someone you need to forgive in the same way God forgives you?
5. How should a community of people who “know the Lord” look different (31:34)? How can you help others experience this kind of transformation? Where can you invest in someone else’s spiritual growth this week?
