SCRIPTURE READING

Acts 3:1-4:4; Acts 4:12; Psalm 2:1-12; Isaiah 35:5-6; Jeremiah 2:13; Amos 4:1-13; Luke 5:17-26

STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Are you facing a surprise storm in any area of your life? How could your faith in the name of Jesus turn this storm of sin or suffering into a season of joy and praise? (3:1-10)
2. How do you see people who have different abilities or means than you? How do you treat them? Does your life show that they are a distraction to the mission or mission critical? (3:2-5)
3. Have you lost the wonder of the gospel? Do you worship a dead god or a living God who still works in our world? We all know the Sunday school answer, but what is the answer of your daily life? (3:10-11)
4. Are you prone to give people too much credit, good or bad, in your life that only belongs to God? Do you blame others as the ultimate source for your hurt? Do you credit anyone other than Jesus with your healing? (3:11-18)
5. Are you as ready to own your own sin as you are to assign sin to others? Are you expecting others, especially leaders, to be flawless or flawed but faithful? In what way do you need to change your mind (repent) about Jesus? Your sin? In what way do you need to change your life's direction to align with Jesus? (3:19-26)
6. What are some early warning signs of storms of sin or suffering in our lives that we often miss? What resources has God given us to endure suffering, whether it is acute, short-term, or chronic? How can we endure unjust persecution for the gospel in any shape it takes? How does Jesus sometimes use this to build the church? (4:1-4)
