Sermon Application Review from 2 Corinthians 2:5–13

Who have you extended forgiveness to this past week (2:5–11)? For whom did you provide care? (2:12–13)?

Scripture Reading

2 Corinthians 2:14–17 2 Corinthians 4:8–12 1 Corinthians 4:9, 13b Ephesians 5:1–2 Galatians 5:22–23 1 Peter 2:9–10 Colossians 1:28–29

Study Questions

- 1. How do you express gratitude for Christ's triumph (2:14a)? In what ways do you feel discouraged over God's apparent inactivity? How have you learned to "walk by faith, not by sight" (5:7)? How is it encouraging that God is "always" leading us in His triumph, even when we can't see it?
- 2. In what specific ways are you the "sweet aroma" of Christ (2:14b)? Who are you currently impacting for Christ? How have you been guilty of having a negative influence on unbelievers?
- 3. In what instances have you experienced rejection for your stance on a biblical or moral issue? How did that affect you? How do you respond to an unbeliever's rejection of Christ (2:15)? How can you overcome discouragement from negative reactions to the gospel?
- 4. What kind of "peddlers" are at work in the church today (2:17)? How do we sometimes exchange the power of the gospel for human cleverness? How can we trust God to make His Word effective? Read Romans 1:16; 1 Corinthians 1:18–31; 2 Corinthians 4:5–6.
- 5. In what ways have you been insincere in your ministry? How do you seek to please God as your primary audience? Read 2 Corinthians 5:9–11; 1 Corinthians 10:31; and Colossians 3:17, 23. Where is there a disparity between your work life and your church life? What step can you take this week to represent Christ more fully?
