SCRIPTURE READING

2 Kings 2:1–14; Deuteronomy 6:6–7; 1 Thessalonians 2:7–8; 2 Timothy 2:1–2;

Titus 2:3-5; 1 Corinthians 4:16-17; 11:1; Ephesians 4:11-12

STUDY QUESTIONS

- 1. How have you sought to finish your Christian life well (2:1)? What principles can you share with others? How do you recognize God's presence and power to sustain you in times of personal transition (2:2-6)? How did you experience God's faithfulness, and how can you trust Him in your current season of change?
- 2. Who in your life has passed on wisdom or spiritual leadership to you (2:9)? How can you "pass the mantle" to someone else in your family, church, or community (2:13)? What steps can you take to intentionally invest in the next generation?
- 3. What bold requests are you making in your life of faith (2:9-11)? What might it look like to ask God for more responsibility? How can you be bolder in your requests while still submitting to His will?
- 4. In what areas of your life do you need God to give you a clearer vision of what He is doing, beyond what is immediately visible (2:12)? How does understanding that God's work is bigger than any one individual help you navigate feelings of inadequacy or fear about your role in His kingdom? What ways can you take comfort in knowing that God's kingdom work will continue even when you are not the one serving?
- 5. How does understanding that God's faithfulness is generational help you live with purpose in your current season of life (2:13-14)? What can you do today that will have an impact on future generations (i.e., your children, grandchildren, your community, or your church)?
