SCRIPTURE READING

Luke 24:1-12; Matthew 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-8; John 20:1-10; John 11:25-27;
1 Corinthians 15:12-20; Philippians 3:10-11

STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Where are you expecting loss instead of hope (24:1-3)? Where in your life do you feel confused, discouraged, or weighed down? How is your pain shaping how you see your circumstances?
2. What has Jesus said that you are forgetting (24:6)? How are you interpreting your life through your feelings instead of His promises?
3. How are you responding to God's truth (24:8, 12)? Do you embrace it or resist it when it challenges you? What would it look like to move from confusion to trust this week?
4. What will you do with what you know (24:8-11)? What is one step of obedience you can take this week? Who needs to hear the resurrection hope you have heard and believed?
5. In what specific ways are you living like Jesus is alive (24:9-12)? Since the resurrection is true, what habits, attitudes, or fears need to change in your life?
