3. What aspect of God's word do I need to become more familiar with?

Exodus 20; Leviticus 19; John 20; Romans 12

STUDY QUESTIONS

1. How does Moses use the historical event of Baal-peor (Numbers 25) to emphasize the importance of obedience?
2. What does Deuteronomy 4:6-8 reveal about Israel's role among the nations?
3. What does Moses' emphasis on remembering suggest about the nature of spiritual growth?
4. How do God's imminence and transcendence appear in verses 10-12, and why is it important to hold both in tension?
5. What are some "basic" truths of the Christian faith that you tend to forget?
6. Can you recall a time when remembering God's past faithfulness helped you through a difficult situation?
7. What spiritual disciplines help you remember what God has done for you?
8. How are you passing on the truths of God's Word to your children or those you disciple?
9. What role does the Sunday gathering play in helping you remember the gospel?
