- 4. How do God's imminence and transcendence appear in verses 10–12, and why is it important to hold both in tension?
- 5. What are some "basic" truths of the Christian faith that you tend to forget?
- 6. Can you recall a time when remembering God's past faithfulness helped you through a difficult situation?
- 7. What spiritual disciplines help you remember what God has done for you?
- 8. How are you passing on the truths of God's Word to your children or those you disciple?
- 9. What role does the Sunday gathering play in helping you remember the gospel?
