STUDY QUESTIONS

3. How does the story of Lazarus, Martha, and Mary reassure us in times of grief? How does the process of lament, i.e., “turn, complain, ask, and trust” (Vroegop, 2019) move us through grief?
4. How does John 11:35 minister to you?
5. How is Jesus’s complete divinity and complete humanity demonstrated in John 11.
