- 4. What role does love play in the Christian life? How does love fulfill God's Law? How do you see this love lived out in your community group? What is one way you can grow in your love for one another? (5:13-14)
- 5. In what ways have you treated the church as an occasional gathering only when it's convenient? What would it take to prioritize your relationships with your family of faith how this passage envisions? (5:13-14)
