Study Questions

1. When you think about who you are, does “sent by Jesus” top the list? Is it even on the list? Do the priorities you set daily demonstrate you belong to Jesus and are sent to be his representative in this world? (Galatians 1:1)
2. Do you have a favorite method for sharing the gospel? Paul makes a beeline for the gospel in his letters: are you ready to share the gospel if God gives an opportunity? How can your community group help equip each other to get ready? (Galatians 1:1, 3-4)
3. Paul wrote “and all the brothers and sisters with me:” who is with you in your pursuit of following Jesus? Are you in close relationships with brothers and sisters in a community group or a men’s or women’s discipleship group? How have those relationships been key to your growth as you look back over your life, or what is an area you hope to see growth through these kinds of relationships? (Galatians 1:2)
4. In your day to day life, where are you struggling to rely solely on God’s grace to experience lasting peace? Where are you seeing progress? (Galatians 1:3)
5. In what ways do you feel weighed down by the “present evil age” that Jesus came to rescue you from? In what ways do you look forward to experiencing the age to come? How are you living in light of eternity? (Galatians 1:4-5)
