STUDY QUESTIONS

- 1. How much do you rely on your own confidence and achievements to get through life? If you compared your walk with Christ from a few years ago to now, would you say you know Him better?
- 2. Has God used you recently in a way that is unique to your personality, background, and strengths? When do you feel most used by God?
- 3. Do you question or struggle with the thought that everything in your life is "loss" and "rubbish" as compared to knowing Jesus or do you agree unreservedly?
- 4. Read John 15:14-17. Do those around you know you as someone who knows Jesus?
- 5. As you look towards 2026, what changes, if any, do you see yourself making in order to know Jesus deeper than ever before? Which of the three disciplines (reading the Word regularly, praying regularly, attending church and groups in person regularly) will you lean into in 2026? Who will you ask to hold you accountable?
