

Talk It Over July 8-9, 2023

"I will say of the Lord, He is my Refuge and my Fortress, my God; on Him I lean and rely, and in Him I [confidently] trust!" - Psalm 91:2 (AMPC)

"And whatever you do [no matter what it is] in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus and in [dependence upon] His Person, giving praise to God the Father through Him." - Colossians 3:17 (AMPC)

What is our purpose? What is God's purpose for us?

The answer is the same – The manifestation of His glory in the everyday events of our lives.

He has made us "trustees" of all His Kingdom glory – literally, all of His Kingdom provision is available to us at all times.

The question is - are you available for His Kingdom purpose?

"Entrust" literally means to "place something beside, to set alongside, or place before someone."

It is the picture of a precious treasure being deposited as a "trust" into the hands of ("authority of") other persons.

Trusting God is abiding and resting in Him, protected, embraced, and surrounded by his covenant love, compassion, and favor.

The word for "trust" in this Psalm 91:2 means "to adhere to."

When we trust in God, we blend our lives into Him, and He blends His life into us.

Every area of our life where we trust God is the strongest area of our life.

As His "trustees," we are entrusted with the unlimited provisions of His Kingdom.

We must be honest and trustworthy. We must be skillful in wisdom. We must be fruitful and productive. We must trust Him completely. We must be responsible and accountable. We must be faithful to what has been entrusted to us.

Then we will experience Proverbs 3:10 (TPT) – "Then every dimension of your life will overflow with blessings from an uncontainable source of inner joy!"
