"This is in keeping with my own eager desire and persistent expectation and hope, that I shall not disgrace myself nor be put to shame in anything; but that with the utmost freedom of speech and unfailing courage, now as always heretofore, Christ (the Messiah) will be magnified and get glory and praise in this body of mine and be boldly exalted in my person, whether through (by) life or through (by) death. One of our world's greatest needs is for God's people to come back to the heart of worship.

True worship is the expression of a heart in awe of God's greatness.

It is in pure heart-felt worship that we begin to see, understand and enter into the fullness of His Kingdom.

When you desire Him – His Presence, His glory – more than you desire your next breath, you experience true worship.

Paul's one goal in life was to "go hard after God." Paul savored Him, treasured Him, and was always satisfied in Him.

Pursuit is the proof of desire. When you are satisfied in Him, you cease to focus on what you need from Him.

True worship is all about "who" He is. We don't worship Him to receive from Him – we worship to give Him all of us – spirit, soul, body.

Heart does not refer to the physical organ. In Scripture, it is used to refer to the seat and center of human life.

It is the center of personality and controls the intellect, emotions, and will, and more than 800 times, it occurs in the Bible.

The heart generates thoughts that make the decisions that the mind works out.

Our soul is the highest element of our physical being. We are created "a living soul."

"Strength" expresses itself when the heart is energized, when the mind is intense, and when the soul is on fire with enthusiasm, passion.
