

## **Talk It Over May 7-8, 2022**

"And God said, 'Let the Earth put forth [tender] vegetation: plants yielding seed and fruit trees yielding fruit whose seed is in itself, each according to its kind, upon the Earth.' And it was so. The Earth brought forth vegetation: plants yielding seed according to their own kinds and trees bearing fruit in which was their seed, each according to its kind. And God saw that it was good (suitable, admirable) and He approved it." - Genesis 1:11-12 (AMPC)

"For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by and to His own glory and excellence (virtue)." - II Peter 1:3 (AMPC)

Constantly, in every act of living, we sow, and we reap.

We reap what we sow.

We reap more than we sow.

We reap in a different season than we sow.

We reap in proportion to what we sow.

All seeds are genetically programmed to produce "after their kind."

The embryo inside the seed is made up of a small shoot and a small root. The root is the first to emerge from the seed. As it grows, it anchors the plant to the ground and absorbs water.

Within each of us is a spirit-life system that is activated as we give, sow, and plant ourselves into the soil of His Kingdom.

Immediately upon surrendering, giving, sowing, planting our life into His Kingdom, a spiritual root begins to grow within us.

Just as your physical frame – body, mind, will, emotions – is made complete by Him, so also your spiritual life.

Every living thing is made up of cells. Each of us has up to 100 trillion cells, and each cell is very complex.

The largest molecule within a cell is DNA. It is the genetic code, the map, that determines every detail of your being.

The seeds of our greatness are locked up within us. You and I hold within us the seed of someone's miracle.

We are "destined seed." Our destiny in greatness – victors, conquerors, overcomers.

The seeds for your comeback are within you. Get up and sow you.

Circumstances, sin, disobedience, and failure do not lower His expectations for you!

Don't die with your "seed" not sown. Give up that seed and reap your harvest!
