September 17-18, 2022**

*“He made known His ways [of righteousness and justice] to Moses, His acts to the children of Israel.”
- Psalm 103:7 (AMPC)*

“The Lord said to Moses, ‘Depart, go up from here, you and the people whom you have brought from the land of Egypt, to the land which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, To your descendants I will give it. I will send an Angel before you, and I will drive out the Canaanite, Amorite, Hittite, Perizzite, Hivite, and Jebusite.’ And the Lord said, ‘My Presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest.’ And Moses said to the Lord, ‘If Your Presence does not go with me, do not carry us up from here!’” - Exodus 33:1-2, 14-15 (AMPC)

Within every person, there is a connection gene – you could call it a longing for belonging.

We all need to feel a sense of worth, that we matter to someone, and that our life has meaning beyond simple existence.

Even though sin entered the beauty of the Garden and interrupted this covenant relationship, God has never ceased to bring about reconciliation and restoration between mankind and His God.

The number one purpose of His Kingdom is to bring us all together under one King – Jesus Christ.

The purpose of all worship, all prayer, all teaching, all preaching, and all spiritual counseling is not to solve man’s problems but to bring him into the presence of Jehovah God.

Literally, to know Him face-to-face. We must learn to seek His face – not His hand.

God knowledge is found on two levels: You may know God’s ways, or you may know God’s acts.

One is to know God by observation; the other is to know Him intimately, personally, passionately – to know His character.

When you understand His ways, your life will be transformed.

Having spent 80 days in God’s Presence on the mountain, Moses was not content to live one day without that Presence.

“Presence” comes from a Hebrew word that means “to turn the face.”

It means “to fill up, to pervade, to permeate, to overspread, to be under the eyes of, or in the face of.”

When you choose to live close to Him, He will sustain you, support you, and energize you.

He becomes your spiritual compensation package – salvation, healing, deliverance, protection, and provision.
