"For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live]." - Ephesians 2:10 (AMPC)

"For those whom He foreknew [of whom He was aware and loved beforehand], He also destined from the beginning [foreordaining them] to be molded into the image of His Son [and share inwardly His likeness], that He might become the firstborn among many brethren." - Romans 8:29 (AMPC)

Whatever greatness we achieve as mortal human beings, there will always be an emptiness, a void, an unfulfilled desire for something more.

The limitations of our physical/mental life must be meshed with the unlimited Presence of His Holy Spirit.

You are designed with a capacity for God within you so that through your behavior, God would express His nature and His character.

Your behavior is intended by God to be a pure expression of His divine essence.

God's ability (power) is never diminished by your inability (lack of power).

We become the instruments of a higher power than our flesh alone is capable of.

Our spiritual destiny is activated. We become supernatural in our Kingdom actions.

Our human nature is illuminated, transfigured, and reborn so as to transcend our normal, natural self.

His purpose, His desire, His imagination all reproduce themselves within us.

This transformation and transcendence are evidenced in your daily life:

- -once dead in trespasses and sins now their hearts throb and tingle with spiritual life;
- -once children of wrath now heirs and possessors of grace, mercy, and peace;
- -once their powers were limited their sensibilities were poisoned, their nature stifled beneath a load of evil thoughts and habits;
- -now fellow citizens with God's people, rising continuously in holiness and Christ-like love.

What happened in the very beginning – His Holy Spirit moved upon the face of the waters, bringing order out of chaos and light out of darkness – moves powerfully and victoriously to separate us out from the world, from death to eternal life.
