"My frame was not hidden from You when I was being formed in secret [and] intricately and curiously wrought [as if embroidered with various colors] in the depths of the Earth [a region of darkness and mystery]. Your eyes saw my unformed substance, and in Your book all the days [of my life] were written before ever they took shape, when as yet there was none of them." - Psalm 139:15-16 (AMPC)

Literally, you are, you become what your dominant thoughts are.

You and I are spiritually capable of thinking the thoughts of God.

As God knows you, you will know yourself. In His Presence, there is a continual unveiling of why you are, who you are, and your Kingdom purpose.

Have you spent enough time in His Presence to know His thoughts and to know His plan for you, the works He desires you to accomplish?

He wrote the script of your life. Are you living that script, or have you written your own script, or have you allowed pain, circumstance, and others to write that script?

In His book for you, He redeems your detours, erases your sins, causes all the pain and negative things to be transformed into good things, and made to bless you.

Knowing every detail of your life, He still chose you, loves you, affirms you, accepts you, and nothing, and no one can ever change that!
