“And saying, ‘The [appointed period of] time is fulfilled (completed), and the Kingdom of God is at hand; repent (have a change of mind which issues in regret for past sins and in change of conduct for the better) and believe (trust in, rely on, and adhere to) the Good News (the Gospel).’” - Mark 1:15 (AMPC)

“You have commanded us to keep Your precepts, that we should observe them diligently. Oh, that my ways were directed and established to observe Your statutes [hearing, receiving, loving, and obeying them]!” - Psalm 119:4-5 (AMPC)

We must recognize, believe and live by these covenant laws to live the “Dominion Covenant” of Genesis 1:28.

As His “Agents of Change,” we choose the path we take in life. With each choice, we create circumstances that align with that choice.

Every cause – thought, word, action – has an effect, a result, a consequence.

Jesus’ first message to His followers is to repent – change your mind, change your direction, change your reason for living.

Jesus, Who never changes, comes to us as a “Change Agent.”

His Kingdom – based on His laws – comes to us for our transformation – literally, changing us into a new form.

Major transformational changes occur in our lives when three things happen in this order:

1. Pain - It is only when the pain level and level of discomfort get great enough that we choose to change.
2. Hope - It means “a sense of favorable and confident expectation of good, a contented and joyful expectation of the future.”
3. Strategy - Always we must have a workable plan for change to be most effective.

Strategy must contain three principles:

- 1) Plan - A detailed description of a plan of action with practical action steps to implement.
- 2) Purpose - An explanation of why, what, when, and where.
- 3) Product - What is your desired and expected result of your plan?

When you know where you have been, and you know where you are going, you never have to worry about where you are.
