

Talk It Over December 31, 2022 - January 1, 2023

Luke 19:13 (AMPC)

"Calling ten of his [own] bond servants, he gave them ten minas [each equal to about one hundred days' wages or nearly twenty dollars] and said to them, 'Buy and sell with these while I go and then return.'

I John 2:1 (AMPC)

"My little children, I write you these things so that you may not violate God's law and sin. But if anyone should sin, we have an Advocate (One Who will intercede for us) with the Father—[it is] Jesus Christ [the all] Righteous [upright, just, Who conforms to the Father's will in every purpose, thought, and action]."

The single greatest asset God has provided His children is the authority to operate in Kingdom power on Earth.

All of this is accessed through prayer and fasting.

Jesus placed prayer in three dimensions:

Approaching God as Father, Friend, and Judge.

- 1. We approach God as Father for our own needs. John 16:23 (TPT)
- 2. We approach God as Friend for the needs of others. Luke 11:5-8 (TPT)
- 3. We approach God as Judge when we are dealing with an adversary. Luke 18:1-8 (TPT)

The purpose of an adversary is to deny you what God has rightfully promised you.

The word means "one who brings an accusation or a legal action against you."

"Adversary" means "an opponent in a lawsuit." Literally, "to stand against rights" or "what is respectfully ours."

Jesus defeated Satan through His sufferings, death, Resurrection, and Ascension to the Father's right hand.

He gave His children power of attorney to operate His Kingdom on Earth.

To absolutely overcome Satan, our adversary, our accuser, we must pray and fast.

Fasting and prayer bring a saturation of God's Presence into our lives, reducing Satan's works to a zero.

I John 2:1 says Jesus is our Advocate (Defense Attorney) with the Father.

Jesus has never lost a case. He has already won every battle. The war is over. Step into God's Throne Room in Jesus' Name and declare your victory.

Occupy – perform, execute, and transact Kingdom business by never allowing Satan a victory.
