“Wait and listen, everyone who is thirsty! Come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Yes, come, buy [priceless, spiritual] wine and milk without money and without price [simply for the self-surrender that accepts the blessing]. Seek, inquire for, and require the Lord while He may be found [claiming Him by necessity and by right]; call upon Him while He is near. ‘For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways,’ says the Lord. ‘For as the heavens are higher than the Earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.’” - Isaiah 55:1, 6, 8-9 (AMPC)

“Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams].” - Ephesians 3:20 (AMPC)

God’s thoughts fill our heart and mind as we worship in His Presence.

And thus, the powerful result of worshipping Him...we live a life above and beyond!
