"Then the Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath or spirit of life, and man became a living being." - Genesis 2:7 (AMPC)

"Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]." - Ephesians 3:20 (AMPC)

It is impossible to require of Him too much. It is not that we need more of Him – He needs more of us.

How much does God have of you?

Our greatest danger is that of putting too little emphasis on His Kingdom message.

He wants to pour into us a deeper insight of His Kingdom – an ongoing spiritual presence that is, at the same time, a human experience.

As we link our lives to His, we learn from Him how to live our lives and how to invest our human capital – time, resources, and energy – into His Kingdom work.

Our nature is suitably adapted by God – (His image and likeness) to be His instruments, vessels on the Earth.

With our lives meshed into His life – His life meshed into ours – our nature then has surprising abilities to transcend itself, to go beyond itself.

Our cooperation is required – God does not work in a vacuum.

Though we cannot contain God's fullness, we may receive it to the full measure of our capacity and to the degree of our "yieldedness" to Him.

E – Everlasting power

The Tree of Life was given to us to feed God's life into us.

Get high on God, feed on His Word, and drink in deeply of His Holy Spirit.
