

The Myth of a Static Faith Jude Jude 3–4, 12–13, 20–25 (NIV)

Jude, concerned the church was drifting away from the truth of God, urges God's people to "earnestly contend" for their faith in Christ. Today God is inviting us to learn how to contend for faith, and move ever closer to Him, because our faith will not simply survive in stasis mode—if we are not moving closer to our God, there is only one other direction.
