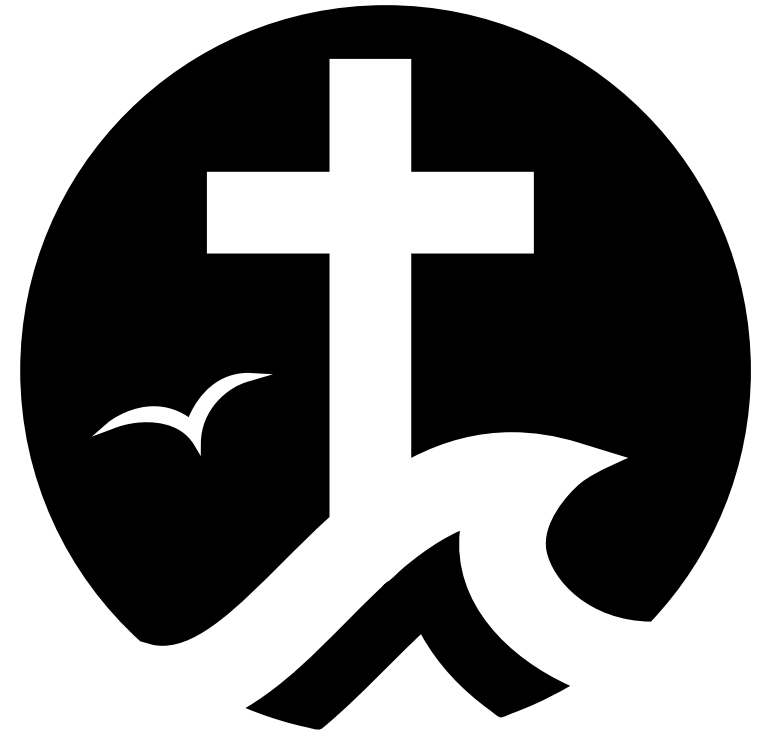

## Jonah; God's Grace on Display

Part 4

### Don't let hate get the best of you

#### 1. Don't let hate pollute your mind with evil thoughts.

"Jonah was greatly displeased and became furious. <sup>2</sup> He prayed to the Lord, "Please, LORD, isn't this what I said while I was still in my own country? That's why I fled toward Tarshish in the first place. I knew that you are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger, abounding in faithful love, and one who relents from sending disaster. <sup>3</sup> And now, LORD, take my life from me, for it is better for me to die than to live."  
*Jonah 4:1-3 (CSB)*

<sup>43</sup> You have heard that it was said, **Love your neighbor** Leviticus 19:18 and hate your enemy. <sup>44</sup> But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, <sup>45</sup> so that you may be children of your Father in heaven. For he causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. <sup>46</sup> For if you love those who love you, what reward will you have? Don't even the tax collectors do the same? <sup>47</sup> And if you greet only your brothers and sisters, what are you doing out of the ordinary? Don't even the Gentiles do the same? <sup>48</sup> Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.  
*Matthew 5:43-48 (CSB)*

#### 2. Don't let hate prevent you from receiving God's kindness.

"The LORD asked, "Is it right for you to be angry?" <sup>5</sup> Jonah left the city and found a place east of it. He made himself a shelter there and sat in its shade to see what would happen to the city. <sup>6</sup> Then the LORD God appointed a plant, and it grew over Jonah to provide shade for his head to rescue him from his trouble. Jonah was greatly pleased with the plant.  
*Jonah 4:4-6 (CSB)*

<sup>6</sup> Seek the Lord while he may be found; call to him while he is near. <sup>7</sup> Let the wicked one abandon his way and the sinful one his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, so he may have compassion on him, and to our God, for he will freely forgive. <sup>8</sup> "For my thoughts are not

your thoughts, and your ways are not my ways." This is the Lord's declaration. <sup>9</sup> "For as heaven is higher than earth, so my ways are higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. <sup>10</sup> For just as rain and snow fall from heaven and do not return there without saturating the earth and making it germinate and sprout, and providing seed to sow and food to eat, <sup>11</sup> so my word that comes from my mouth will not return to me empty, but it will accomplish what I please and will prosper in what I send it to do." *Isaiah 55:6-11 (CSB)*

#### 3. Don't let hate poison your heart against God's Grace.

<sup>7</sup> When dawn came the next day, God appointed a worm that attacked the plant, and it withered. <sup>8</sup> As the sun was rising, God appointed a scorching east wind. The sun beat down on Jonah's head so much that he almost fainted, and he wanted to die. He said, "It's better for me to die than to live." <sup>9</sup> Then God asked Jonah, "Is it right for you to be angry about the plant?" "Yes, it's right!" he replied. "I'm angry enough to die!" <sup>10</sup> And the LORD said, "You cared about the plant, which you did not labor over and did not grow. It appeared in a night and perished in a night. <sup>11</sup> So may I not care about the great city of Nineveh, which has more than a hundred twenty thousand people who cannot distinguish between their right and their left, as well as many animals?"

<sup>32</sup> Two others—criminals—were also led away to be executed with him (*Jesus*). <sup>33</sup> When they arrived at the place called The Skull, they crucified him there, along with the criminals, one on the right and one on the left. <sup>34</sup> Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, because they do not know what they are doing. And they divided his clothes and cast lots. <sup>35</sup> The people stood watching, and even the leaders were scoffing: "He saved others; let him save himself if this is God's Messiah, the Chosen One!" <sup>36</sup> The soldiers also mocked him. They came offering him sour wine <sup>37</sup> and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself!" <sup>38</sup> An inscription was above him: This Is the King of the Jews."  
*Luke 23:32-37 (CSB)*
