

Philippians: Live Under The Authority of Christ

Part 2 Keep a Kingdom Outlook

1. Recognize God's hand in the circumstances of life.

¹²Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually advanced the gospel, ¹³so that it has become known throughout the whole imperial guard, and to everyone else, that my imprisonment is because I am in Christ. ¹⁴Most of the brothers have gained confidence in the Lord from my imprisonment and dare even more to speak the word fearlessly."

Philippians 1:12-14 (CSB)

¹⁹But Joseph said to them, "Don't be afraid. Am I in the place of God? ²⁰You planned evil against me; God planned it for good to bring about the present result—the survival of many people. ²¹Therefore don't be afraid. I will take care of you and your children." And he comforted them and spoke kindly to them." *Genesis 50:19-21 (CSB)*

2. Rejoice in the proclamation of Jesus Christ as Lord.

¹⁵To be sure, some preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of good will. ¹⁶These preach out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel; ¹⁷the others proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, thinking that they will cause me trouble in my imprisonment. ¹⁸What does it matter? Only that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is proclaimed, and in this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice ¹⁹because I know this will lead to my salvation: through your prayers and help from the Spirit of Jesus Christ. ²⁰My eager expectation and hope is that I will not be ashamed about anything, but that now as always, with all courage, Christ will be highly honored in my body, whether by life or by death." *Philippians 1:15-20 (CSB)*

¹I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus, who is going to judge the living and the dead, and because of his appearing

and his kingdom: ²Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; correct, rebuke, and encourage with great patience and teaching. ³For the time will come when people will not tolerate sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, will multiply teachers for themselves because they have an itch to hear what they want to hear. ⁴They will turn away from hearing the truth and will turn aside to myths. ⁵But as for you, exercise self-control in everything, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry."

3. Realize God's plan includes you now and forever.

²¹For me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²²Now if I live on in the flesh, this means fruitful work for me; and I don't know which one I should choose. ²³I am torn between the two. I long to depart and be with Christ—which is far better—²⁴but to remain in the flesh is more necessary for your sake. ²⁵Since I am persuaded of this, I know that I will remain and continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith, ²⁶so that, because of my coming to you again, your boasting in Christ Jesus may abound. ²⁷Just one thing: As citizens of heaven, live your life worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or am absent, I will hear about you that you are standing firm in one spirit, in one accord, contending together for the faith of the gospel, ²⁸not being frightened in any way by your opponents. This is a sign of destruction for them, but of your salvation—and this is from God. ²⁹For it has been granted to you on Christ's behalf not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him, ³⁰since you are engaged in the same struggle that you saw I had and now hear that I have." *Philippians 1:21-30 (CSB)*

¹So if you have been raised with Christ, seek the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. ²Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. ³For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory." *Colossians 3:1-4 (CSB)*

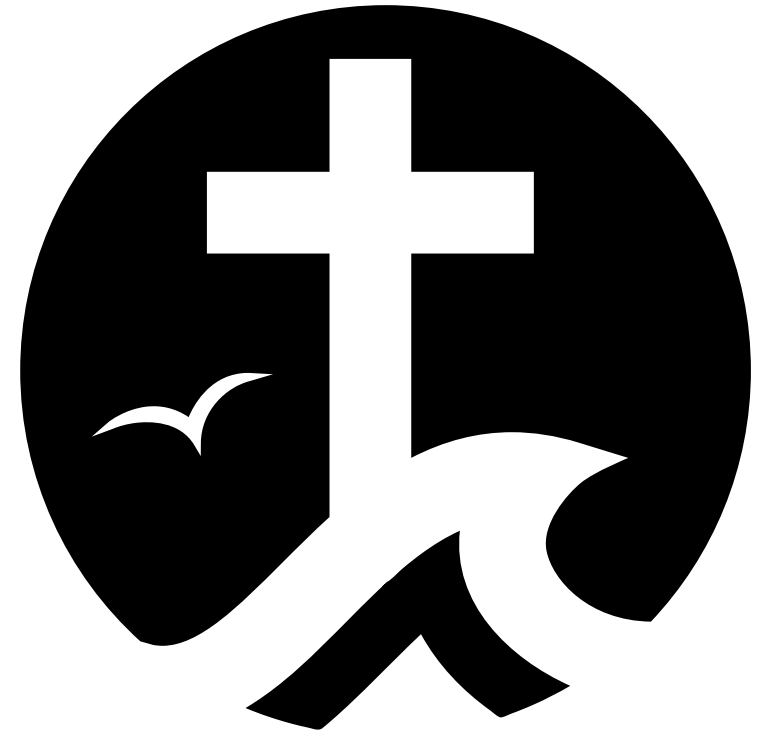
