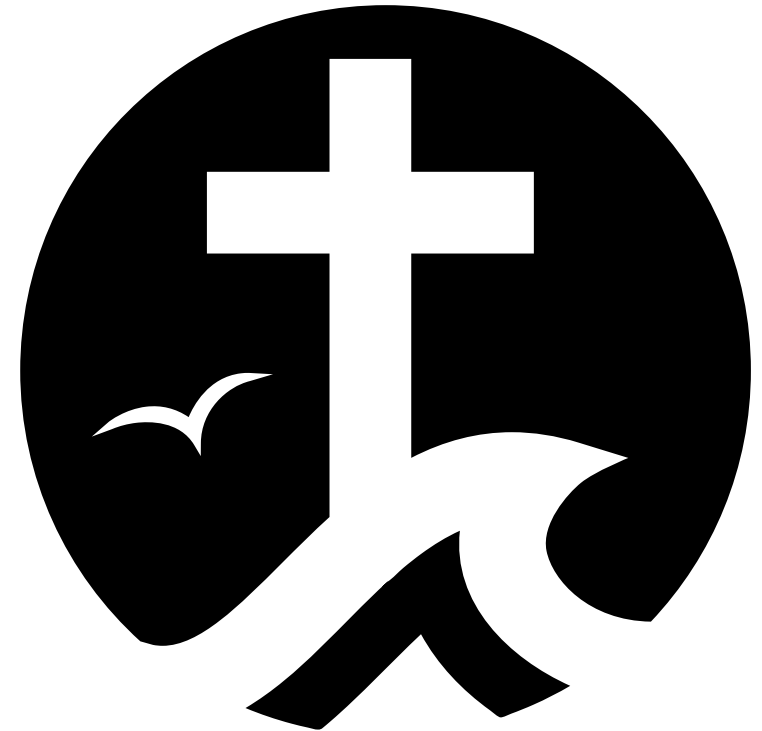

Part 24

Be People of Prayer

1. Pray Consistently in The Holy Spirit.

¹⁸Pray at all times in the Spirit . . . ” *Ephesians 6:18 (CSB)*

²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness, and self-control. The law is not against such things. ²⁴Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.” *Galatians 5:22-26 (CSB)*

¹What is the source of wars and fights among you? Don't they come from your passions that wage war within you? ²You desire and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and wage war. You do not have because you do not ask. ³You ask and don't receive because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures. ⁴You adulterous people! Don't you know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? So whoever wants to be the friend of the world becomes the enemy of God. ⁵Or do you think it's without reason that the Scripture says: The spirit he made to dwell in us envies intensely? ⁶But he gives greater grace. Therefore he says: **God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble.** ⁷Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ⁸Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. ⁹Be miserable and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. ¹⁰Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.” *James 4:1-10 (CSB)*

2. Pray Constructively in Faith.

¹⁸. . . with every prayer and request, . . . ” *Ephesians 6:18 (CSB)*

⁵Whenever you pray, you must not be like the hypocrites, because they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street

corners to be seen by people. Truly I tell you, they have their reward. ⁶But when you pray, go into your private room, shut your door, and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you. ⁷When you pray, don't babble like the Gentiles, since they imagine they'll be heard for their many words. ⁸Don't be like them, because your Father knows the things you need before you ask him. ⁹“Therefore, you should pray like this: Our Father in heaven, your name be honored as holy. ¹⁰Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹Give us today our daily bread. ¹²And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. ¹³And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. ¹⁴“For if you forgive others their offenses, your heavenly Father will forgive you as well. ¹⁵But if you don't forgive others, your Father will not forgive your offenses.”

Matthew 6:5-15 (CSB)

3. Pray Consciously for God's will to be done.

¹⁸. . . and stay alert with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints. ¹⁹Pray also for me, that the message may be given to me when I open my mouth to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel. ²⁰For this I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I might be bold enough to speak about it as I should.” *Ephesians 6:18-20 (CSB)*

¹³. . . Be at peace among yourselves. ¹⁴And we exhort you, brothers and sisters: warn those who are idle, comfort the discouraged, help the weak, be patient with everyone. ¹⁵See to it that no one repays evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good for one another and for all. ¹⁶Rejoice always, ¹⁷pray constantly, ¹⁸give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. ¹⁹Don't stifle the Spirit. ²⁰Don't despise prophecies, ²¹but test all things. Hold on to what is good. ²²Stay away from every kind of evil.” *1 Thessalonians 5:13-22 (CSB)*
