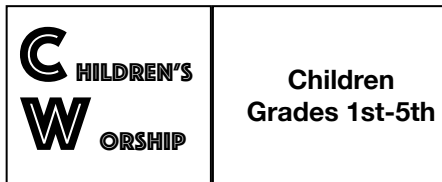

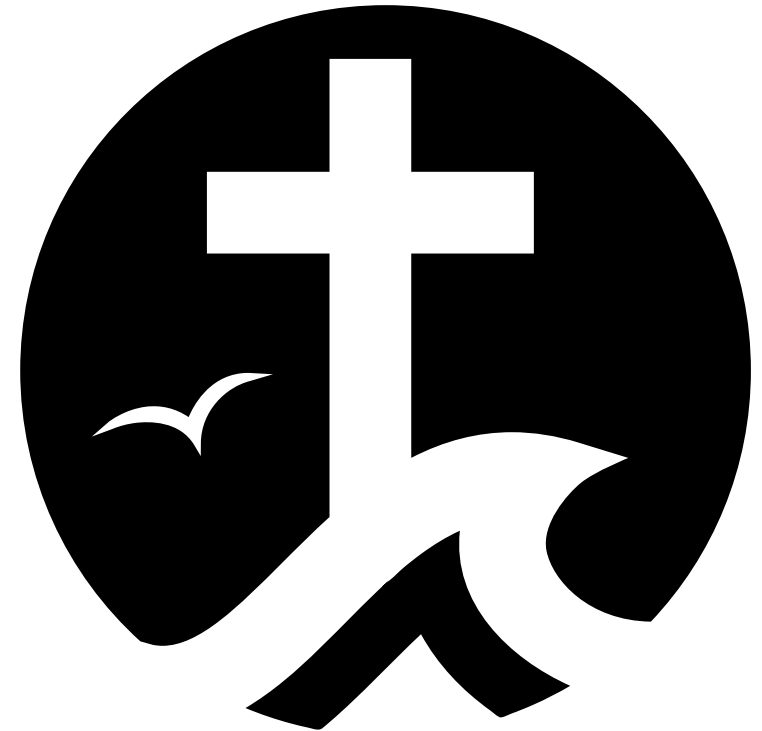

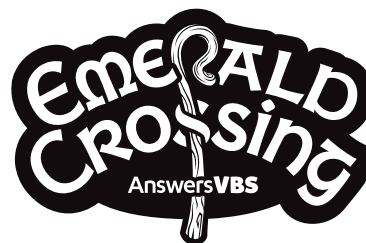

Philippians: Live Under The Authority of Christ

Part 10

What are you learning?

1. Are you learning to **manipulate** or to **appreciate**.

¹⁰I rejoiced in the Lord greatly because once again you renewed your care for me. You were, in fact, concerned about me but lacked the opportunity to show it. *Philippians 4:10 (CSB)*

¹We want you to know, brothers and sisters, about the grace of God that was given to the churches of Macedonia: ²During a severe trial brought about by affliction, their abundant joy and their extreme poverty overflowed in a wealth of generosity on their part. ³I can testify that, according to their ability and even beyond their ability, of their own accord, ⁴they begged us earnestly for the privilege of sharing in the ministry to the saints, ⁵and not just as we had hoped. Instead, they gave themselves first to the Lord and then to us by God's will. *2 Corinthians 8:1-5 (CSB)*

2. Are you learning to **grumble** or to **humble** yourself.

¹¹I don't say this out of need, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances I find myself. ¹²I know how to make do with little, and I know how to make do with a lot. *Philippians 4:11-12 (CSB)*

¹What is the source of wars and fights among you? Don't they come from your passions that wage war within you? ²You desire and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and wage war. You do not have because you do not ask. ³You ask and don't receive because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures. ⁴You adulterous people! Don't you know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? . . . " . . . Therefore he says: God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. *Proverbs 3:34* ⁷Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ⁸Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. ⁹Be miserable and mourn and weep. Let your

laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. ¹⁰Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you. *James 4:1-10 (CSB)*

3. Are you learning to **mistrust** or to **trust** in Christ.

. . . In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being content—whether well fed or hungry, whether in abundance or in need. ¹³I am able to do all things through him who strengthens me. *Philippians 4:12-13 (CSB)*

²Consider it a great joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you experience various trials, ³because you know that the testing of your faith produces endurance. ⁴And let endurance have its full effect, so that you may be mature and complete, lacking nothing. ⁵Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God—who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly—and it will be given to him. ⁶But let him ask in faith without doubting. For the doubter is like the surging sea, driven and tossed by the wind. ⁷That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord, ⁸being double-minded and unstable in all his ways. *James 1:2-8 (CSB)*
